

## NCA Judges' Council Symposium: Alternate Hotel Reservations

The Arlington Hilton has run out of rooms for us on the nights of October 25<sup>th</sup> and 26<sup>th</sup>. There are many other good options nearby and some include free parking, which the Hilton does not.

I suggest doing a computer search for hotels within a mile of, or closest to, the Arlington Hilton, Ballston, VA. You may find popular travel search engines helpful. A fee in the \$200's is reasonable for the DC area. A walk, an uber or a cab can easily get you to the Hilton. (The hotel contract only gave us 37 rooms at the \$119+ rate.)

The Marine Corps Marathon will take place on Sunday, the 27<sup>th</sup>. It will begin at 7:55 a.m. on Route 110 between the Pentagon and Arlington National Cemetery. The route goes into the District and ends back in the Rosslyn section of Arlington, which is closer to DC than Ballston.
